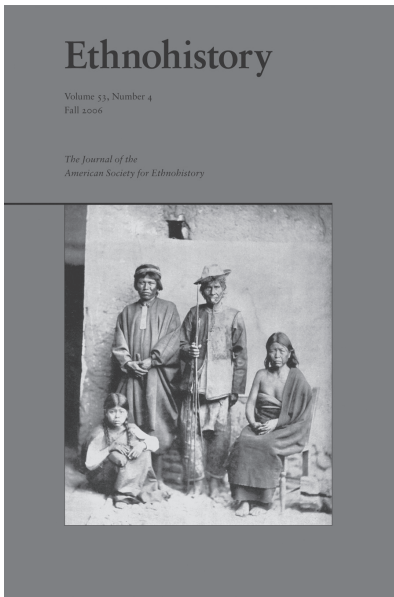


American Society for Ethnohistory
