CALL FOR PAPERS

We invite proposals for panel sessions and papers on any topic within ethnohistory. Complete panel proposals with a chair and a commentator are preferred, but individual paper proposals will also be considered.

Panel proposals should include a title and 1-page abstract of the topic. In addition, each presenter on the panel should include a title and a 1-paragraph abstract of the paper. Ideally, each panel will include a chair and discussant. Panels will be 100 minutes long. Panels normally include 3 or 4 papers and include time for comments and discussion.

The rolling deadline for paper and panel submissions ends on May 15, 2018. Applicants will be notified of the status of their proposals no later than June 15, 2018. It is not necessary to register for the conference in order to have a paper or panel accepted. Once papers and panels are accepted, however, participants should register and pay for the meeting on the ASE website. Registration is required of all participants and attendees.
